



Ground rules for Steinreich Sommerbibelschule

We attend the Steinreich Sommerbibelschule to learn more about God's word and to grow together spiritually. In order to make the most of SSBS, we commit ourselves to the following rules and promise to help and support each other.

THE RULES ARE:

- Respect each other politely in word and deed as students, teachers and house parents so that everyone may feel accepted.
- No student or volunteer may leave the yard or receive visit without the permission of the house parents.
- Please note that our classes and activities are carefully designed to be age-appropriate. We ask that you ensure your child attends during the designated week. If this policy is not followed, we may need to take appropriate actions to ensure the effectiveness of the program.
- Drop-off is Monday at 7am at the Steinreich Bibelschule Campus in campo 38.5.
(No kids are allowed to be dropped off on Sunday.)
- Pick up is Friday at 1:30pm.
- Visits between boys and girls in dormitories are not allowed.
- Under no circumstances is it allowed for students to date during SSBS.
- Everyone is to dress properly; Shorts should be long. Tops should have sleeves and cover the midriff. (Shirts with bad pictures and camouflage clothing are not allowed).
- Under no circumstances is it allowed to bring the following:
 - Electronics such as cellphones, tablets and laptops; or weapons that can be used to hurt yourself or others. If found, it will be taken away and must be picked up by the parents for a penalty of \$1,000 pesos.
 - Junk food or glow sticks. If found, it will be taken away for the week and the house parents will decide what to do with it.
- If the students cause any damage during SSBS, it is expected that the parents pay for it.
- The Steinreich Sommerbibelschule committee and/or the Steinreich Bibelschule is not responsible for any accidents the children may have. Such expenses are to be covered by the parents.
- We expect everyone to follow the schedule in order to make the most of SSBS.
- Report to the dorm-parents if your child needs to take any type of medication during their week at SSBS. If this is not reported, SSBS is not responsible for overdose or any other harm that could be caused because of the medications.
- No pranks of any kind are permitted.
- Drugs, alcohol, vaping, cigarettes, etc. are not permitted. If anything like this is found on campus it will be confiscated and not returned. The parents will be contacted and a decision will be made by the SSBS committee whether the student can stay on campus or not.
